As you are aware, the State's Office of Tourism, Trade and Economic Development approved the City's joint application for a boundary change adjustment. The approval expanded the number of participating municipal governments from four to eight and with the expansion comes an increase in Dania Beach's representation on the advisory board from one position to two.

The City's enterprise zone is composed of an area that is inclusive of CRA and non-CRA city land; therefore, representation on the board should reflect this balance with the Community Development Department and the CRA representing the City on the board. With these appointments, Dania Beach's representation on the advisory board will reflect that of the other participating municipalities.

Both Mr. Daniels and Mr. Earle are willing to serve on the Advisory Board.

In accordance with section 290.0055 (6), Florida Statutes, our Office reviewed the Broward County request to amend the boundary of the Broward County Enterprise Zone (EZ-0601). The purpose of this letter is to inform you that your boundary amendment request has been approved. Our approval is based on the information provided in the following resolutions:

The effective date of this Enterprise Zone designation will be October 1, 2010 and will be in effect until December 31, 2015. As a result of this approval, businesses and residents located within the designated 19.78 square mile area will be eligible for the financial incentives offered by the state pursuant to the Florida Enterprise Zone Program for eligible transactions that are undertaken on or after October 1, 2010.

We hope the amended boundary of the Broward County Enterprise Zone will enhance your development and revitalization efforts in Broward County and the other jurisdictions that have areas located within the amended Enterprise Zone.
