


Mayor and City Commission:


Dear Commissioners and Mayor:

Statement of Qualifications:

I am a twenty four year resident of the city of Dania Beach, married for 34 years, having raised two children and now am the Grandfather of two children.

I ran for City Commissioner in the 2012 elections and, in the process, attended many civic meetings and made the acquaintance of many of my fellow citizens in all sections of our city, whose concerns I share. Although frequently labeled as "sections" of the city, we are all residents of the larger group: the city of Dania Beach. To this end, we all share common goals.

Concerns of the residents that I am aware of include, but are not limited to the following:

The economic factors affecting our lives.

The cleanliness and appearance of the city.

The safety of our residents.

The stability of our property tax rates.

The quality of our social services.

The promotion of businesses in the city.

Downtown Redevelopment.

Raising the bridge height at Federal Highway, over the Dania Cutoff Canal.

I am a member of the "Friends of the Dania Beach Library" and a member of the Dania Beach Airport Advisory Board, in addition to frequently attending other civic meetings, such as the Marine Advisory Board and the Cultural Arts Board.

As the owner of a successful "start-up" business, following a lengthy career as a member of organized labor (the International Alliance of Theatre and Stage Employees), I have respect for both sides of Labor/Management issues, with advanced insight into policies that affect and govern both.

In the last municipal election, I was endorsed by the Sun-Sentinel newspaper. I also succeeded in the enacting of an ordinance in our city, prohibiting the manufacturing, sale or possession of "synthetic cannabanoid substances" and other toxic substances that have the potential to destroy lives.

The city of Dania Beach, although embroiled in "Small Town Politics" has real world issues that are not limited to smaller municipalities. As a longtime resident of Dania Beach, and for reasons outlined above, I believe that I remain uniquely qualified to share my knowledge for the betterment of Dania Beach.
