SUBJECT: Authorizing consultant services for the Oasis Neighborhood Improvement Projects – Oasis V, VI, VII and VIII

It is recommended that Pump Utilities Management Planning Services provide consultant services for the design, construction and project management of Oasis projects: V, VI, VII and VIII. This request includes waiving a competitive bid process for consulting services. The Charter of the City of Dania Beach, Part III, Article 3, Section 4, Subsection (j), authorizes the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and materials for the city government without the bidding process for purchases under the maximum threshold of \$25,000. The following is a brief description of each upcoming Oasis project:

- Oasis V: Street beautification, solar lighting, storm drainage in area on NE 1st Court and NE 2nd Avenue (39th Year CDBG project)
- Oasis VI: Street beautification, solar lighting, storm drainage in area on SW 9th Street and SW 4th Street
- Oasis VII: Street beautification, solar lighting, storm drainage in area on NW 11th between Community Garden NW 1st Street to NW 2nd Street
- Oasis VIII: Neighborhood entrance beautification and guard houses for Melaleuca Gardens

The funding resource for this contract will be provided from account # 001-18-00-519-31-10.

Recommendation

The City Commission approve the attached resolution and authorize certain City Officials to execute the attached agreement with Public Utilities Management Planning Services.
