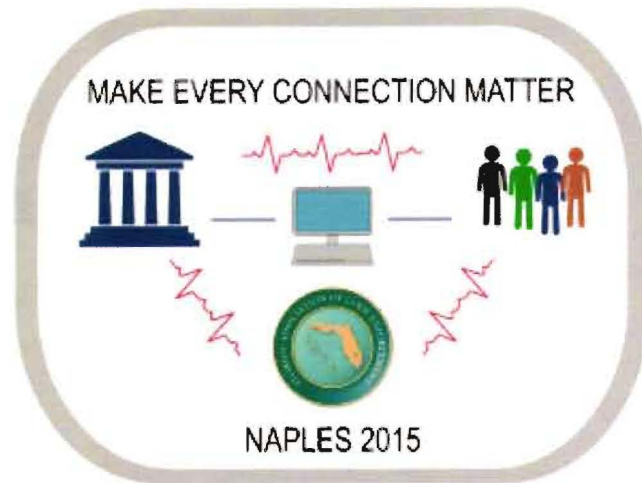

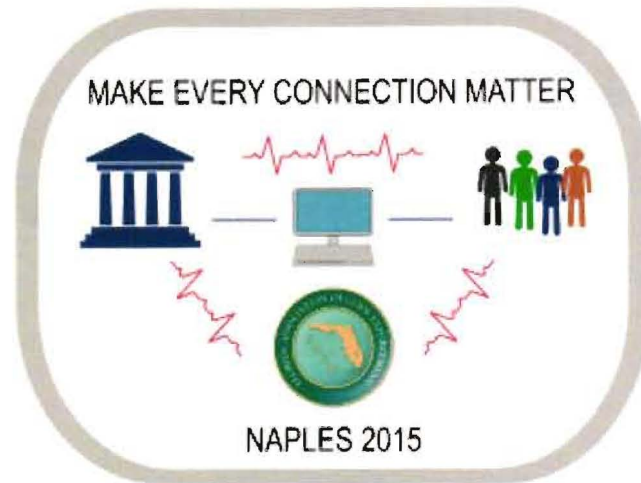

Meals and Incidental Expenses (M&IE) Breakdown


