Regarding the 2 new variance requests you are proposing, you must submit an application 7 week prior to a public hearing to allow for public notification to occur per state and local law. Therefore it is not possible for you to submit new applications for variances for the City Commission meeting occurring in 2 weeks.

In addition, there is still a fence and sidewalk that needs to be constructed, which must be included in a bond, unless you can provide a letter from Broward County stating that they will be constructing both.

In light of these issues, we recommend that you submit a letter to us requesting to withdraw your request so that you can continue to resolve these issues. You will have to pay for a new public notification for any upcoming public hearings. Alternatively, if we proceed for the July 28th City Commission meeting staff will recommend denial, as many issues are still not resolved.
