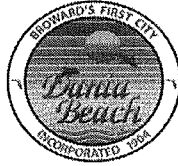

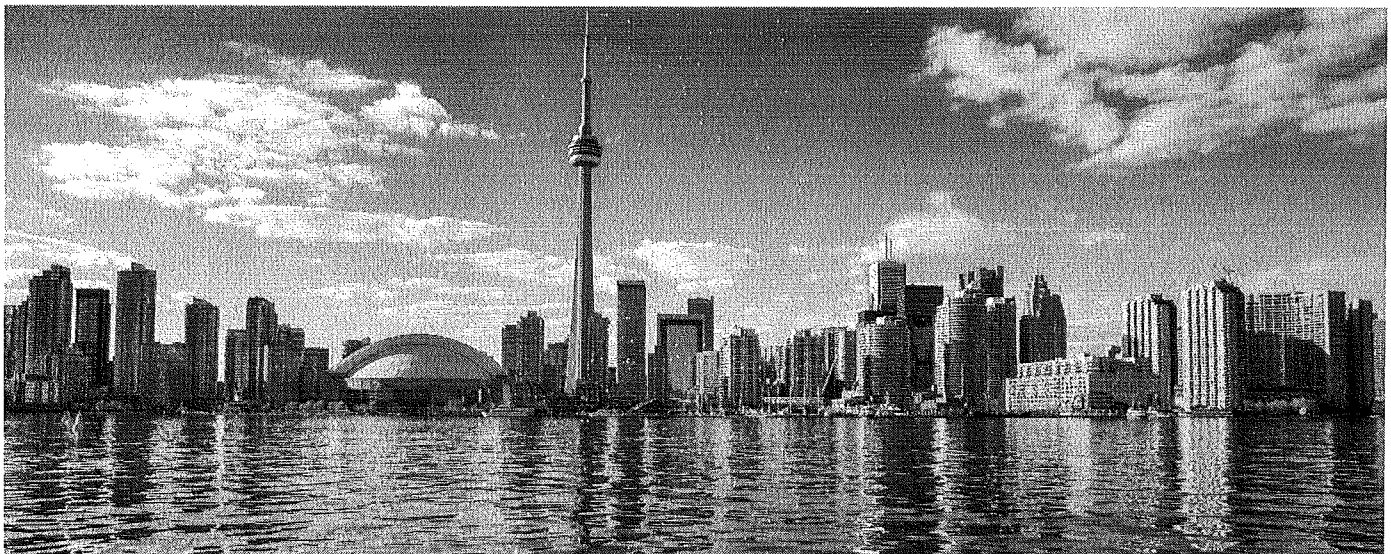
Toronto Transit Commission

You can expect to receive a confirmation within three business days of booking your room reservation. A major credit card valid until June 2016 or later or a check for one night's room and tax (add 13% tax) is required to secure a reservation. Credit cards and checks are for guarantee only and are not charged to hold reservations.
