Summary Explanation & Background:

This was originally cited on 2/4/12 for 9 violations. This went to the Special Magistrate on 9/6/12 for 6 violations. The Special Magistrate Mark Berman issued an order giving the respondent until 10/16/12 to comply or a fine of \$200.00 per day would be levied. At the 3/7/13 hearing, the Special Magistrate Gordon Linn confirmed the fine as a lien. The fine ran from 10/16/12 through 12/15/14, 790 days @ \$200.00 per day = \$158,000.00 plus recording/admin fees of \$216.00, for a total of \$158,216.00. The City received a total settlement of \$2,500.00 for code fines.
