RATIONALE:

To improve the professional appearance of the Dania Beach Fire Rescue organization through improved uniformity and daily dress attire.

OPERATIONAL GUIDELINE:

Shift Personnel: (Rank inclusive through Battalion Chief)

08:00 to 17:00 Navy embroidered polo shirt, Navy BDU pants, black approved boots / shoes

17:00 to 08:00 Navy embroidered Jumpsuit, black boots

Short sleeve Class A white or blue shirt is to be worn with dark blue dress trousers

Long sleeve Class A white (plain white undershirt), worn with; black tie, black trousers, black shoes

Day Personnel Fire Prevention:

Black polo, black slacks (no BDU), black shoes, belt badge

Call in for fire investigation: Jumpsuit, black approved boots / shoes

Day Personnel Administration:

Office: Class A short sleeve, white shirt(plain white undershirt), dark blue trousers, black shoes

Class A long sleeve, white shirt(no open collars, plain white undershirt), black tie, black trousers, black shoes

Optional Dress-down attire; Black polo, black trousers (no BDU pants), black shoes, belt badge

Patches and pins: City of Dania Beach Fire Department patch on both shoulders, paramedic pin to be placed on class A uniforms; above nameplate, service, and or any received honor pins

Formal attire denotes: Class A white, long sleeve shirt, black tie, black trousers, black shoes
